The State Commission on Judicial Conduct determined on December 12, 2007 that Hon. Dennis LaBombard should be removed from judicial office.

That determination of the Commission, its findings of fact, its conclusions of law, and the record of the proceedings upon which the determination is based were transmitted on December 13, 2007 to the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals in accordance with subdivision (a) of section 22 of Article 6 of the New York State Constitution and with Judiciary Law, section 44, subdivision 7;


The service and notice requirements of the New York State Constitution, Article 6, section 22, subdivision (a) and of Judiciary Law, section 44, subdivision 7, were complied with on December 13, 2007 by certified mail, return receipt requested;

Proof of service was obtained that Hon. Dennis LaBombard received, on December 16, 2007, the determination of the Commission, findings of fact, conclusions of law and record of the proceedings upon which the determination is based.

Hon. Dennis LaBombard requested, on January 14, 2008, that the Court of Appeals review the Commission's determination, and an order of this Court dismissing the requested review for want of prosecution pursuant to Rule 530.6(a) of this Court's Rules was entered on March 13, 2008; NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Judiciary Law, section 44, subdivision 7, it is

ORDERED that Hon. Dennis LaBombard is removed from judicial office in accordance with the findings of the Commission.
