IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between Robert H.

Tembeckjian, Administrator and Counsel to the Commission on Judicial Conduct

("Commission"), and the Honorable Jason Novak ("Respondent") as follows:

- Respondent has been a Justice of the Hornby Town Court, Steuben County, since 2020. His term expires December 31, 2023. Respondent is not an attorney.
- 2. Respondent was served with a Formal Written Complaint dated May 14, 2021, containing two charges. Charge I alleged that, for more than a year following the commencement of his judgeship in January 2020, Respondent failed to complete the judicial certification training program required by Article VI, Section 20(c) of the New York State Constitution and Section 105(a) of the Uniform Justice Court Act for all non-lawyer town and village court justices. Charge II alleged that Respondent failed to cooperate with the Commission during its investigation of the matter. The Formal Written Complaint is appended as Exhibit A.
- Respondent enters into this Stipulation in lieu of filing an Answer to the Formal Written Complaint.

Respondent has tendered his resignation, by letter dated and effective June 7. 2021, a copy of which is appended as Exhibit B.

Pursuant to Section 47 of the Judiciary Law, the Commission has 120 days from a judge's resignation to complete proceedings and, if it so determines, render and file a determination that the judge should be removed from office.

Respondent affirms that, having vacated his judicial office, he will neither seek nor accept judicial office at any time in the future.

Respondent understands that, should be abrogate the terms of this Stipulation and hold any judicial position at any time in the future, the present proceedings before the Commission will be revived and the matter will proceed to a hearing before a referee.

Upon execution of this Stipulation by the signatories below, this Stipulation will be presented to the Commission with the joint recommendation that the matter be concluded, by the terms of this Stipulation, without further proceedings.

Respondent waives confidentiality as provided by Section 45 of the Judiciary Law, to the extent that (1) this Stipulation will become public upon being signed by the signatories below, and (2) the Commission's Decision and Order regarding this Stipulation will

become public.

### JASON NOVAK,

a Justice of the Hornby Town Court, Steuben County.

- 1. Article VI, Section 22, of the Constitution of the State of New York establishes a Commission on Judicial Conduct ("Commission"), and Section 44, subdivision 4, of the Judiciary Law empowers the Commission to direct that a Formal Written Complaint be drawn and served upon a judge.
- 2. The Commission has directed that a Formal Written Complaint be drawn and served upon Jason Novak ("Respondent"), a Justice of the Hornby Town Court, Steuben County.
- 3. The factual allegations set forth in Charges I and II state acts of judicial misconduct by Respondent in violation of the Rules of the Chief Administrator of the Courts Governing Judicial Conduct ("Rules").
- 4. Respondent has been a Justice of the Hornby Town Court, Steuben County, since January 1, 2020. His term expires on December 31, 2023. Respondent is not an attorney.

### **CHARGE I**

5. For more than a year following his ascension to judicial office in January 2020, Respondent failed to complete the judicial certification training program required for all non-lawyer town and village court justices by Article VI, Section 20(c) of the New York State Constitution and Section 105(a) of the Uniform Justice Court Act.

### Specifications to Charge I

- 6. Pursuant to Article VI, Section 20(c) of the New York State Constitution and Section 105(a) of the Uniform Justice Court Act, all non-lawyer town and village court justices are required to successfully complete a certification training program and file a certificate of completion with their municipalities before assuming the functions of office.
- 7. In November 2019, the position of Hornby Town Justice was vacant and on the general election ballot. According to the Steuben County Board of Elections, Respondent won the election with a single write-in vote.
- 8. A certification training program was offered by the New York State Office of Court Administration (OCA) in December 2019, but Respondent did not attend because his election had not yet been certified.
- 9. On or about February 5, 2020, Respondent filed his oath of office with the Hornby Town Clerk. On or about February 10, 2020, Respondent filed his oath of office with OCA.
- 10. An OCA certification training program that was scheduled for April 2020 was cancelled because of the coronavirus pandemic.

- 11. An OCA certification training program was scheduled for September 2020. However, in advance of that program, Respondent notified OCA that he would be unable to attend because of his full-time job responsibilities.
- 12. Additional OCA certification training programs were scheduled for and conducted in December 2020 and April 2021. Respondent did not register for or attend either of those programs.
- 13. To date, Respondent has not received his judicial certification. Nor has he heard any cases or performed any judicial work. Respondent is not collecting his judicial salary.
- 14. By reason of the foregoing, Respondent should be disciplined for cause, pursuant to Article VI, Section 22, subdivision (a), of the Constitution and Section 44, subdivision 1, of the Judiciary Law, in that Respondent failed to uphold the integrity and independence of the judiciary by failing to maintain high standards of conduct so that the integrity and independence of the judiciary would be preserved, in violation of Section 100.1 of the Rules; failed to avoid impropriety and the appearance of impropriety, in that he failed to respect and comply with the law and failed to act in a manner that promotes public confidence in the integrity and impartiality of the judiciary, in violation of Section 100.2(A) of the Rules; and failed to perform the duties of judicial office impartially and diligently, in that he failed to ensure that his judicial duties took precedence over all his other activities, in violation of Section 100.3(A) of the Rules, and failed to diligently discharge his administrative responsibilities, maintain professional competence in judicial

administration, and cooperate with other judges and court officials in the administration of court business, in violation of Section 100.3(C)(1) of the Rules.

### CHARGE II

15. From in or about January 2021 through in or about March 2021, Respondent failed to cooperate with the Commission during its investigation of the matters herein, in that he failed to respond to four letters inquiring into his conduct.

### **Specifications to Charge II**

- 16. Judiciary Law Section 44(3) and 22 NYCRR Sections 7000.3(c) and (e) authorize the Commission to request a written response from a judge who is the subject of a complaint and to require a judge's testimony during its investigation.
- 17. Respondent received but failed to respond to four letters from the Commission requesting his written response to an inquiry letter dated January 7, 2021, regarding his prolonged failure to complete the required certification training program for town and village court justices. Three letters dated January 27, 2021, February 8, 2021, and February 16, 2021 were sent to Respondent via priority mail. One additional letter, dated March 1, 2021, was sent via certified mail. Copies of the letters, along with proofs of receipt, are appended hereto as Exhibits 1, 2, 3 and 4, respectively.
- 18. By reason of the foregoing Respondent should be disciplined for cause, pursuant to Article VI, Section 22, subdivision (a) of the Constitution and Section 44, subdivision 1, of the Judiciary Law, in that Respondent failed to uphold the integrity and independence of the judiciary by failing to maintain high standards of conduct so that the integrity and independence of the judiciary would be preserved, in violation of Section

100.1 of the Rules; and failed to avoid impropriety and the appearance of impropriety, in that he failed to respect and comply with the law and failed to act in a manner that promotes public confidence in the integrity and impartiality of the judiciary, in violation of Section 100.2(A) of the Rules.

WHEREFORE, by reason of the foregoing, the Commission should take whatever further action it deems appropriate in accordance with its powers under the Constitution and the Judiciary Law of the State of New York.
